ear Friends and Supporters, As John Hume once said, "Difference is the essence of humanity.... and it should therefore never be the source of hatred or conflict. Therein lies a most fundamental principle of peace: respect for diversity."

The history of community-based services for people with disabilities is preceded by decades upon decades of institutional living. Although institutions later received great scrutiny, in the beginning they served an important purpose by offering a community for those who had none.

Over time, as understanding and acceptance of all disabilities grew, the community-based model emerged. In the 1940s and early 1950s, the efforts of a few groups of determined parents living throughout the United States led to a strong, national movement of parents who began assuming leadership roles, and telling professionals, "We speak for our sons and daughters." Their message was an unapologetic challenge to the validity in the words, "Nothing can be done for your child."

And, so, we broke from segregation, and found we had choices. We moved into an era of integration and engagement. Becoming Independent was one of the first organizations in our area, and one of the largest statewide, to offer programs that reflected the values held in this new era of services.

We are now in the midst of

navigating a mandate from the federal government to exit all congregate settings, and move more fully into the community. But for Becoming Independent, it is first and foremost a mandate from the people we serve. This necessarily has resulted in the need for a paradigm shift in the way we operate, but let me assure you that not only are we ready for this challenge, we are excited about the opportunities for positive change that come with it. We know from history that this shift we are now experiencing is simply the natural progression that all human services providers must experience if they are to grow. And in the same way that organizations before us once moved from segregation to integration, we now move from community integration

to adapt our services to the needs of the people we serve. At the helm of our Passport to Independence program serving young adults on the autism spectrum is a highly qualified and competent staff. We created a unique and powerful curriculum for the program, but it's the students who mold the program when they tell us if a gap exists. And they are the ones who are telling us that they want to engage in activities that secure them a meaningful place

within their community.

Our organization has a robust team of individuals who are ready to take their place in the workforce. They are telling us that they want to be given the same level of responsibility that a neurotypical person would be given in that same position. We provide opportunities for them to naturally engage in environments that, with our without our support,

they can thrive. We help to uncover

and cultivate their innate skill sets,

giving them confidence to pursue

their chosen careers.

We believe that it's our responsibility Sincerely.




