



The Future of Services

Becoming Independent (BI) is about to break ground on a radical reimagining of our main campus, transforming our aging industrial building into a new Program Headquarters for services: a dynamic, multi-dimensional hub - one that's prepared to serve even more of the Bay Area's 9,000 individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities. The redevelopment will look and operate as a post-secondary education and training environment, equipped with state-of-the-art technology and up-to-date air filtration systems to ensure the health and safety of all.



BI's Program Headquarters will have a dedicated 10,000sf flexible program space where innovative and person-centered curriculum will be offered.



Two retractable soundproof walls will divide the program space into three separate rooms that can be utilized for classes.



The people receiving services will be in the driver's seat, deciding which educational path aligns best with their personal goals and interests.



Each room will be equipped to function as a Zoom Room, where people can engage and interact with each other either in-person or virtually.



A variety of classes and activities will be provided around the clock during program hours: ranging from art and job training to social awareness and fitness.



Transportation will be provided to all individuals who are interested in participating in on-site classes or in the community.
